Who will the characters be, where will your story be set and what will happen at the start, middle and end of your story?	<u>Writing the start of your story.</u> Today you will start writing your story. You will need to introduce the characters and describe the setting. Don't forget to use your story plan that you wrote on Monday to help.	<u>Writing the middle of your story.</u> Today you will continue with your story. You will write the build up and the dilemma; what problem is going to happen in your story?	<u>Writing the ending to your story.</u> Today you will finish writing your story. You need to include the resolution (how is the problem going to be fixed) and the closing. Does your story have a happy or a sad ending?	<u>Design a front cover for your story.</u> Don't forget to include the title of your story, the name of the author and the illustrator (if you have included pictures in your book). As an extension - have a go at designing the back cover too. For this you will need to write a blurb. <u>Spelling test.</u>
