These 'Helpful Words' are based on Oxford Reading Tree Book Levels.

Helpful Words' are high frequency words sorted into levels from our Floppy's Phonics scheme. Some of these words are phonetically decodable (children can use their phonic knowledge) and some of these words are tricky words (they don't follow phonic patterns so have to be learnt off by heart.) If children learnt to read and write all 'Helpful Words', their fluency will hugely improve.

This list of Helpful Words includes the all the tricky words listed in Phases 2 to 5 of the Department for Education's Phonics framework; 'Letters and Sounds'. I have put a Letters and Sounds indicator below for your reference.
