

Hispanic Week at OLSJ

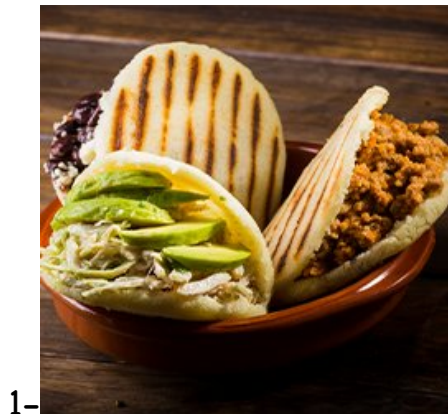
Dear all,

At this time of the year in school, we normally celebrate the Hispanic language and culture. This year we thought it would be a good idea to bring that same atmosphere at home with these three projects:

- 1 -Masterchef: Children can create a Hispanic inspired dish with the ingredients they like the most. As an extra challenge, they also can learn the names of the ingredients they have used in Spanish.
- 2 -The Great Spanish Bake Off: Children can bake a traditional Hispanic bake (for instance churros, rumchata cupcakes, crema catalana, turrón etc...) or decorate their baking taking inspiration from a Hispanic related theme (Day of the Dead cupcakes, cake with a Carnival inspired decoration etc...). Same as the first project, encourage the children to learn the names of ingredients/ dish in Spanish.
- 3 -Artista Espanol: Children can create a piece of art inspired by a Hispanic artist (Frida Kahlo, Goya, Picasso, Dali, Velazquez)

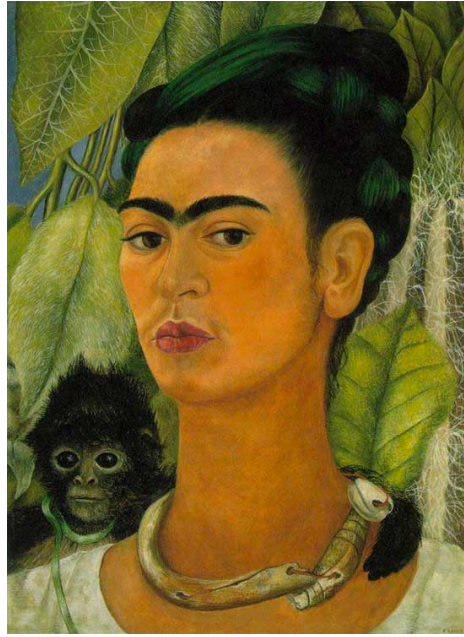
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
