Tuesday 7th March 2023 7:15 pm


This one will be all online.

But also, by law, we'll now be able to raise money and other benefits from all sorts of new sources like companies and funds. The Charity Commission law, requires us to organise an Annual General Meeting (AGM) to set rules through a constitution and to elect a number of officers of the charity - Chair, secretary, treasurer, events and communications leaders.

As all OLSJ parents and carers are a part of the PA, first thing next term we'll be inviting people to be putting themselves up as candidates and everyone to come along to the AGM. Think about if you'd care to be elected.

NB: We'll all be up still for working on PA stuff but the law requires five elected and legally responsible officers.
