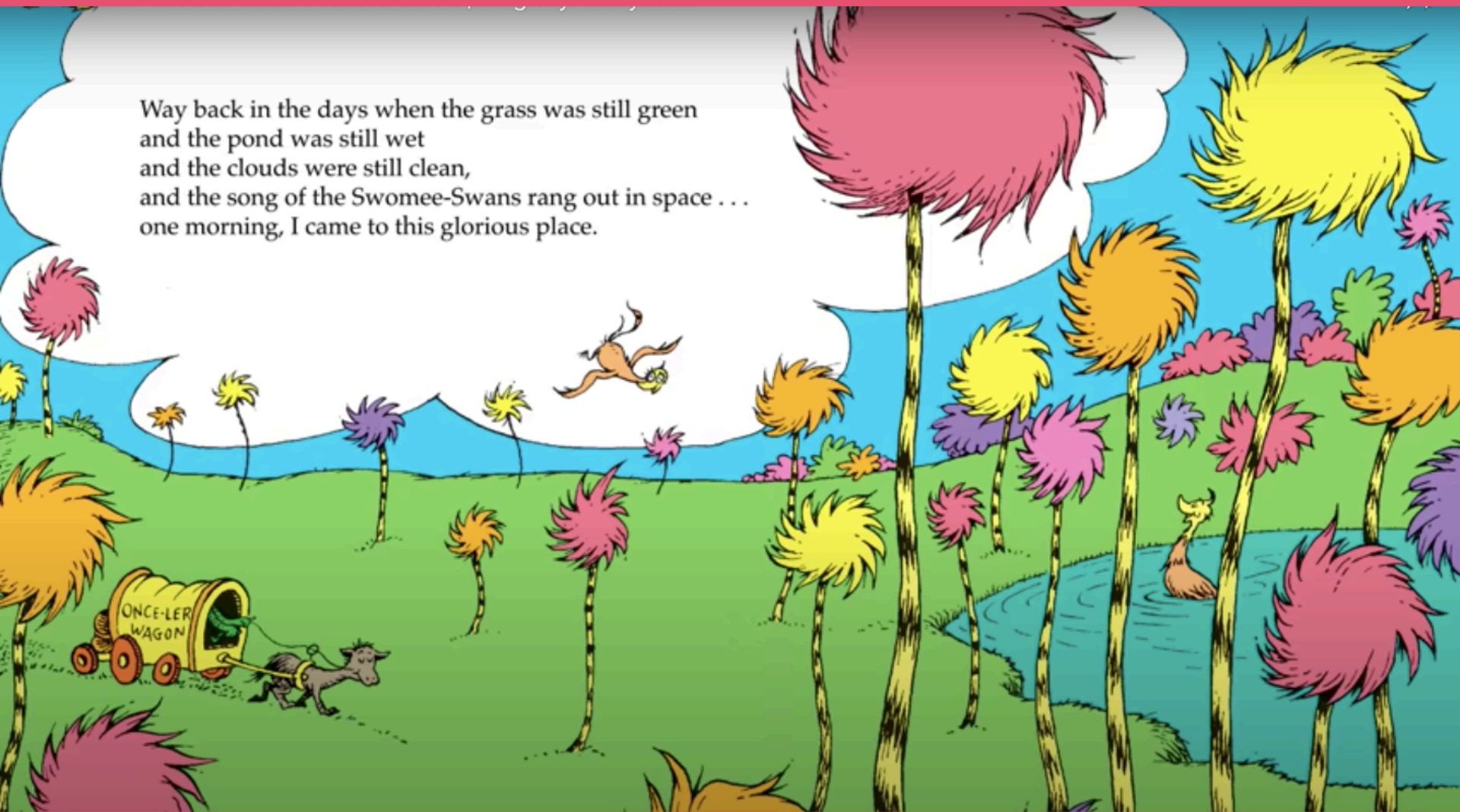

Listen to the story

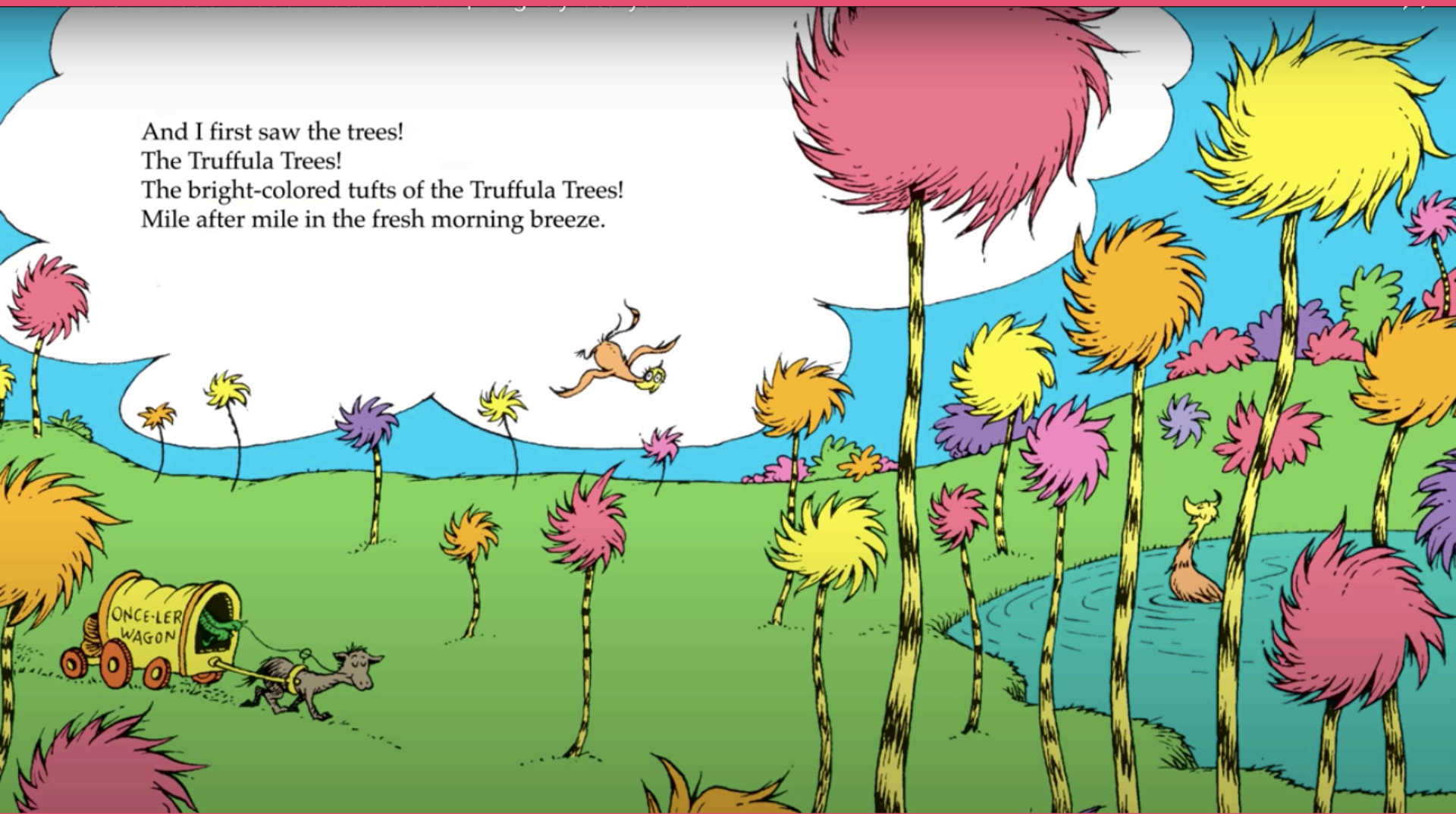
The Lorax is the original eco warrior as he tries to save the Truffula trees from the greedy once-ler's axe...

one morning, I came to this glorious place.

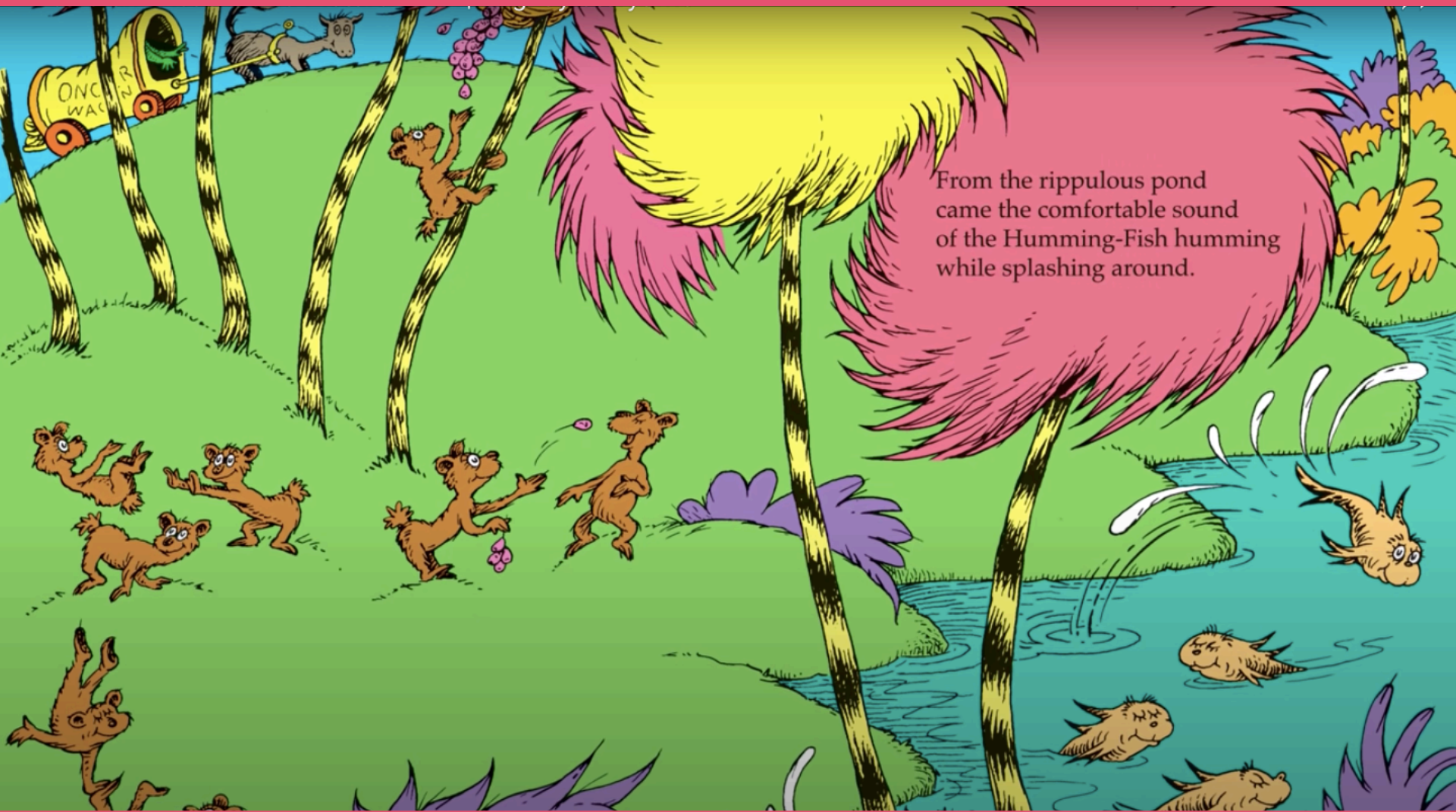


And I first saw the trees!

Mile after mile in the fresh morning breeze.





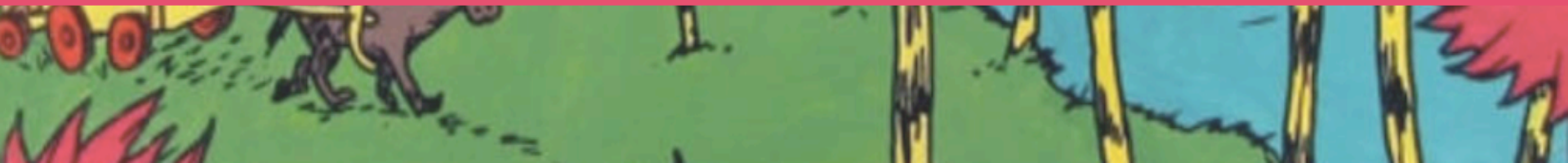
And, under the trees, I saw Brown Bar-ba-loots

as they played in the shade and ate Truffula Fruits.

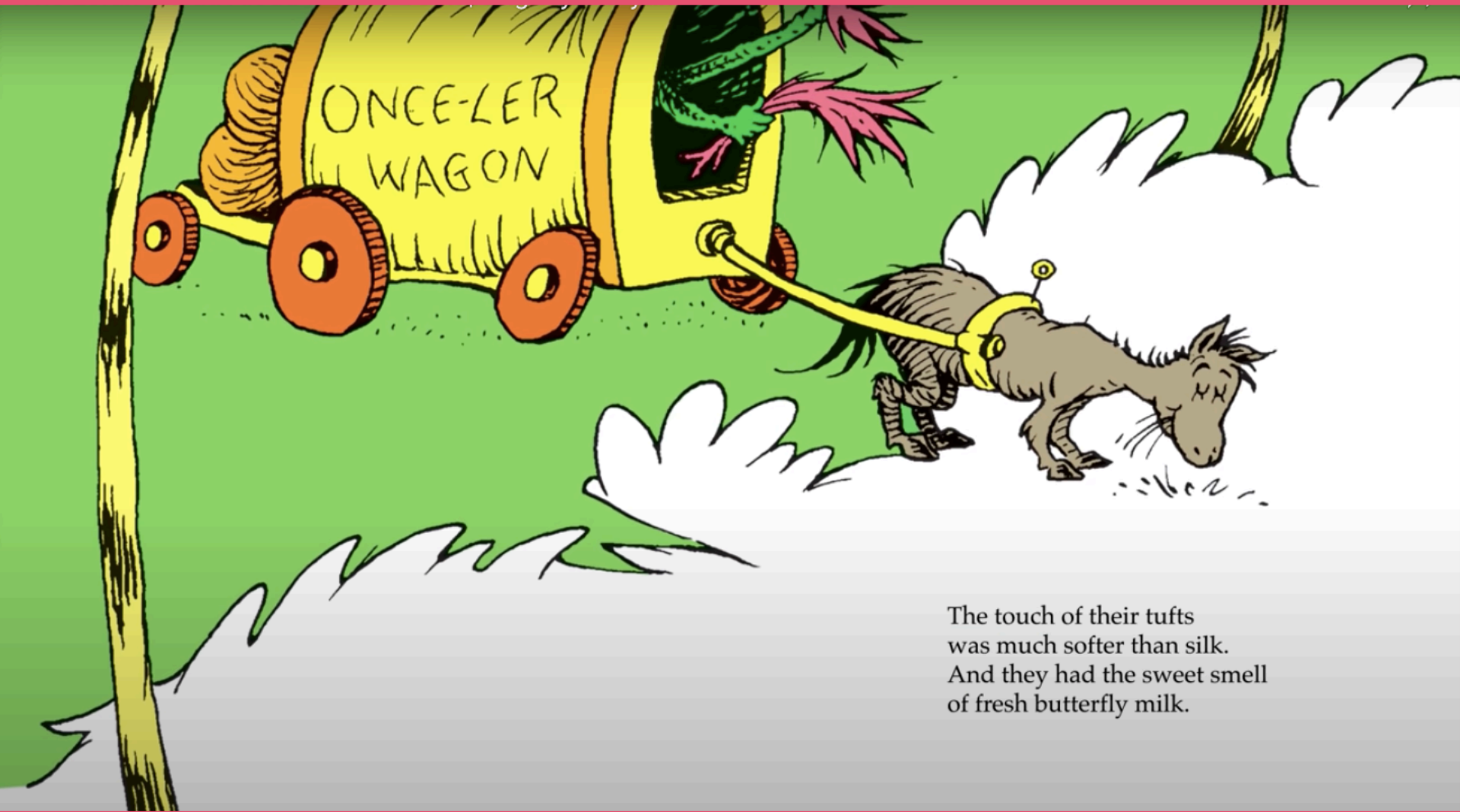


From the rippulous pond

while splashing around.

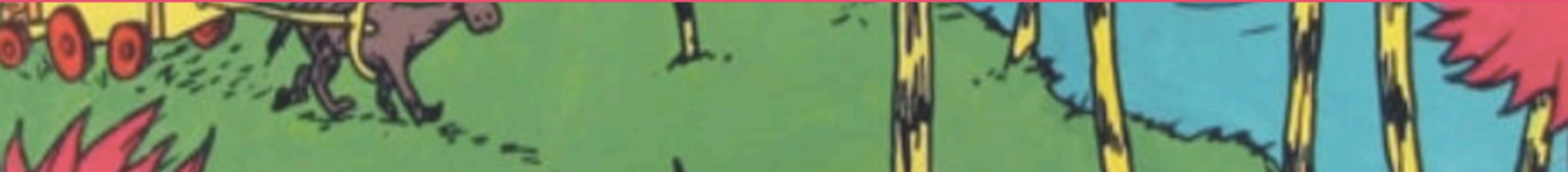


But those *trees*! Those *trees*!
