	English	We will be covering two books Christophe's story by Nicky Cornwell and The Iron Man by Ted Hughes.
	Maths	We will be focusing on <i>Number</i> Place Value, Addition and Subtraction, while practicing fluency and mental maths.
	R.E/R.S.E.	Topics we will cover this term include: Judaism, Mental Health and Emotional Wellbeing, The family of God in Scripture.
	Science	Topics we will cover this term include: Animals including humans (e.g. Functions of the Digestive System) and Living Things and their Habitats.
	History/Geography	Geography: Earthquakes and Volcanoes History: Roman Britain
	Art/D.T.	Art: Sketching and drawing, tint making D.T: Healthy & varied diet, Mechanisms (Pop Up Colosseum)
	P.E.	PE will take place every Wednesday with Mr James. The children will learn Invasion Games and Dance.
	Music	Music will take place every Tuesday, mainly focusing on rhythm and group composition.
	Computing	Computing: Online Safety and Coding
	Spanish	Extend numbers past 20 and revise multiples of ten to 100. Practice questions about wellbeing.
