Synagogue

scroll

The Jewish Scriptures were written by hand on scrolls.
These scrolls were treated with great respect and care and kept in a special place in the synagogue. This box or cupboard was called the Ark to remind the people of the special ark in which the Israelites kept the tablets of the Law on their journey through the desert.
