English 10.00-10.30am	OLI: To read the story and put actions with it. OLI: to write a wanted poster. For the next 2 weeks, we will be focusing on the traditional tale 'The Three Little Pigs', and in the 2"d week the spin off book 'The True Story of the Three Little Pigs'. The aim is to build the children's confidence in extended writing and retelling the story. I often use Pie Corbett's method (also called Talk 4 Writing) to help with this. First children make actions to the story. Then they create a story map to remember the story. Then they create a story map to remember the story. Then they retell the story in written form. Finally they adapt the story and retell it again. I will adapt this format for the next two weeks. Today children are to: 1. read the story in the PowerPoint provided, making up their own actions as they read it. 2. have a go a making a wanted poster for the big bad wolf. Remember to use adjectives to describe the wolf!	OLI: to write a letter.  Imagine you are the wolf. Write a sorry letter to the 3 little pigs.  Remember to start your letter with 'To' or 'Dear' and end your letter with 'from Wolf'.  Because you are pretending to be the wolf you will use 'I' through the letter when referencing the wolf (e.g. I am very sorry).	OLI: to sequence the story using a story map template.  To help children get ready to make their own story map tomorrow, today children will sequence the story using the pictures I have provided. This is a basic story map without key words or time words added.  Once children have stuck the pictures in the right order, encourage them to orally retell the story, pointing to each part as they retell it.	OLI: to make a story map.  Please see the PowerPoint for example story maps. Feel free to use bigger paper.  Steps to Success: - I can draw simple pictures to represent parts of the story I can put the pictures in the correct order I can add key words / sayings I can add time words (first, next, then, after that, finally etc.)  You will use this story map to help you retell the story next week, so keep hold of it!
