Week beginning 13th July

There are four areas I would like you to focus on: Literacy, Phonics and Maths. The red writing relates to all the documents uploaded.

Literacy:

This week I would like you to read the book called 'Perfect' by Danny Parker and Freya Blackwood. Ask your child to think about what things they can do during the summer that can't be done during other season and ask them to draw a picture of their favourite thing to do on a summer day. Phonics:

Introduce the new sound 'J', like 'j, j, j, jelly'. I have made some flipcharts to help your child name some objects that begin with the 'L' sound and to form the grapheme correctly. (Documents uploaded: Sound J Write/ Sound J Words) Please practise the other sounds too.

Maths:

This week I would like your child to focus on read, finish and make patterns. Please explain to your child that a pattern is something that repeats and repeats. Make sure that they grasp the idea first using colours and the patterns provided, but then have a go at making their own patterns. I have provided some examples in the worksheet (Maths - Patterns)
