ACTIVE AND PASSIVE

You can use verbs in two different ways These are often called *voices*.

1. The active voice

Look at this sentence.

Tom *caught* the ball.



Here Tom (subject) is doing the action of *catching*. *Caught* is an <u>active</u> verb.

2. The passive voice

You can say the above sentence the other way round.

The ball was caught by Tom.

Here the ball (subject) is having the action done to it. Was caught is a passive verb.

ACTIVE

The mouse stole the

cheese.



PASSIVE

The cheese was stolen by the mouse.

Jenny ate the ice cream.



The ice cream was eaten by Jenny.
