Happy New Year! I hope you all had a lovely Christmas. Year 3 have had a wonderful first term! Everyone has worked very hard. We have a busy term ahead with lots more learning to be done. Please see below for an outline of what we will be learning this term.

	English	The children will complete activities around a range of texts: fiction, non-fiction and poetry, in line with the Year 3 Curriculum.		
+ - × ÷	Maths	The Year 3 Maths Curriculum will be taught using the White Rose programme of study – Multiplication and Division, Length and Perimeter, Fractions, Mass and Capacity.		
Ŵ	R.E/R.S.E.	Our topics include Local Church, Eucharist and Lent-Easter. The other faith we will learn about is Islam.		
×	Science	In Spring 1 our science focus is 'Rocks'. In Spring 2 our science focus is 'Plants'.		
	History/Geography	Geography – The children will explore 'Climate and Weather' including geographical features. History – The children will learn about The Bronze and Iron Age.		
	Art/D.T.	In Design and Technology, the children will be designing and making a greenhouse structure.		
" ¶"	P.E.	The children will explore dance in the first half of the Spring term and developing their striking and fielding skills in the second half.		
5	Music	The children will learn about scales and melody using tuned percussion. They will also learn about the word 'Ostinato' – repeated bass lines beneath melodies.		
	Computing	The children will learn about emails and email safety.		
F	Spanish	The children will be revising basic questions and answers to be able to hold a short conversation. They will learn new vocabulary such as animals and class commands.
